Invitation for BWF/BEC Coach Education Level 3 Course

Dear Member,

Badminton Europe is happy to announce that we will organize the **BWF/BEC Level 3 Coach Education Course**.

1. General Information

The objectives of the BWF/ BEC Coach Education Level 3 Course are for candidates to:

- Examine their national systems with regard to talent detection and identification
- Apply key aspects of talent development to their own national systems
- Identify key differences in managing elite training environments
- Implement concepts and strategies for elite player development into their coaching practice

2. Prerequisites for participants:

- BWF Level 2 Coach or equivalent
- Minimum of 3 years of coaching experience.
- Should be competent and comfortable discussing high-level content in English
- Will need to undertake significant reading and pre-course tasks (in addition to an extended project following the course)

3. Planning

The course will be held from Wednesday, 1 June 2022 (start at 9:00) to Sunday, 6 June 2022 (expected time to be finished at 15:00).

Participants

Participants are expected to arrive on Tuesday, 31 May 2022 and depart on Sunday, 6 June 2022 in the afternoon. Do not book any flight tickets before 17:30.

Local transport from the airport to the hotel and from the hotel to the airport will be arranged by BEC.

Airport: Airport where participants and experts will be picked up is Copenhagen International Airport (Lufthavnsboulevarden 6, 2770 Kastrup).
